Oregon OSHA - Adopted Changes To Adopt Current Attorney General's Model Rules, and Corrections of Oregon Revised Statutes in Division 1, General Administrative Rules

This rulemaking amends OAR 437-001-0001, Model Rules of Procedure, by adopting the most recent version, in effect January 1, 2008, of the Oregon Attorney General's Administrative Law Manual and Uniform and Model Rules of Procedure Under the Administrative Procedures Act, which is the model and guide for agency rulemaking.

OAR 437-001-0005 Authority and Applicability of Rules, 437-001-0700 Recordkeeping and Reporting, and 437-001-0706 Recordkeeping for Health Care Assaults, are amended to update Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) references. OAR 437-001-0706(4) is also amended to include an additional reference to the Recordkeeping and Reporting rule 437-001-0700.

This is OR-OSHA Administrative Order 8-2008, adopted and effective July 14, 2008.
