About this publication

Oregon OSHA's guide to rules that have special requirements is an Oregon OSHA Standards and Technical Resources Section publication.

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Introduction

We get many calls and e-mails from employers asking the same question. It begins: “Which of your rules have requirements for...”

You can finish the sentence with words like “recordkeeping,” “employee training,” and “respiratory protection.” Wouldn’t it be nice to know the rules with such requirements so that you can determine which ones might apply to your workplace? We thought so.

This guide lists all of those rules and their requirements. We call them *special requirements*, because they’re requirements that you might want to know more about, including:

- **Required programs**
- **Required written documents**
- **Recordkeeping requirements**
- **Certification requirements**
- **Training requirements**
- **Respiratory protection requirements**
- **Exposure monitoring requirements**
- **Medical surveillance requirements**
- **Competent persons requirements**
- **Qualified persons requirements**

How to use this guide

Browse the rules to find those that may apply to your workplace, then use the key below to identify the rule's special requirements:

- P:** **Program-related requirement:** Indicates required programs, which are typically a mix of procedures, policy, and plans necessary to meet a rule's requirements.
- W:** **Written-document requirement:** Indicates required written documents, typically for plans, procedures, records, and equipment inspections.
- RK:** **Recordkeeping requirement:** Indicates rules that have recordkeeping requirements for activities such as injury reporting, equipment inspections, medical monitoring, and hazard communication.
- C:** **Certification requirement:** Usually, "certification" means a written, signed, and dated statement confirming the performance of a requirement – also called a "certification record" in many of our rules.
- T:** **Training requirement:** Indicates rules that have requirements for employee training.
- R:** **Respiratory-protection requirement:** Indicates rules that require respirators or respiratory protection for employees.
- M:** **Exposure-monitoring requirement:** Indicates rules that require exposure monitoring for workplace hazards such as noise, chemicals, and air contaminants.
- MS:** **Medical-surveillance requirement:** Indicates rules that require regular medical examinations and consultations for employees who may be overexposed to hazardous substances during their work.
- CP:** **Competent person requirement:** Indicates rules that have requirements for "competent persons" – the term for someone who can evaluate hazardous conditions and mechanical systems, inspect equipment, and train others to work safely.
- QP:** **Qualified person requirement:** Like the competent person, a qualified person is one who can evaluate hazardous conditions and mechanical systems, inspect equipment, and train others. The qualified person must also have a recognized degree or professional certificate.
- FC:** **Frequently cited as a violation:** A bonus. Indicates a rule that is among the top 10 most violated rules within a division.

Oregon OSHA Services

Oregon OSHA offers a wide variety of safety and health services to employers and employees:

Consultative Services

- Offers no-cost, on-site safety and health assistance to help Oregon employers recognize and correct workplace safety and health problems.
- Provides consultations in the areas of safety, industrial hygiene, ergonomics, occupational safety and health programs, assistance to new businesses, the Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program (SHARP), and the Voluntary Protection Program (VPP).

Enforcement

- Offers pre-job conferences for mobile employers in industries such as logging and construction.
- Inspects places of employment for occupational safety and health hazards and investigates workplace complaints and accidents.
- Provides abatement assistance to employers who have received citations and provides compliance and technical assistance by phone.

Appeals, Informal Conferences

- Provides the opportunity for employers to hold informal meetings with Oregon OSHA on concerns about workplace safety and health.
- Discusses Oregon OSHA's requirements and clarifies workplace safety or health violations.
- Discusses abatement dates and negotiates settlement agreements to resolve disputed citations.

Standards & Technical Resources

- Develops, interprets, and provides technical advice on safety and health standards.
- Provides copies of all Oregon OSHA occupational safety and health standards.
- Publishes booklets, pamphlets, and other materials to assist in the implementation of safety and health standards and programs.
- Operates a Resource Center with a video lending library, books, technical periodicals, and consensus standards.

Public Education & Conferences

- Conducts conferences, seminars, workshops, and rule forums.
- Coordinates and provides technical training on topics such as confined space, ergonomics, lockout/tagout, and excavations.
- Provides workshops covering management of basic safety and health programs, safety committees, accident investigation, and job safety analysis.
- Manages the Safety and Health Education and Training Grant Program, which awards grants to industrial and labor groups to develop training materials in occupational safety and health for Oregon workers.
