Circular blade handling

Problem

File Room employees work in awkward postures and use forceful exertions when handling circular edger blades.

Solution

A cart was fabricated to hold the circular edger blades. The cart is pushed to and from the File Room and has a lifting eye so it can be hoisted to different floor levels. It reduces handling of the blades which also reduces blade damage and the potential for hand cuts.
