OSHA has completed the FY 2015 Comprehensive Federal Annual Monitoring and Evaluation (FAME) Report for the Oregon OSHA State Plan (OR-OSHA). Attached you will find the final report which includes the current status of the completed and continued findings from last year's 2014 follow-up FAME report, as well as any new findings identified during the FY 2015 FAME. All State Plans' FY 2015 Comprehensive FAME Reports will be posted on OSHA's public website on August 2, 2016.

State Plans with open findings from the FY 2015 FAME must submit a FY 2015 Corrective Action Plan (CAP). The CAP tracks each corrective action item's related activities and progress, and includes a concise and detailed response from the State Plan for each OSHA finding and recommendation. Since the OR-OSHA FY 2015 Comprehensive FAME Report did have an open finding, please complete and submit the attached CAP template to me by Monday, August 15, 2016.

In addition, OR-OSHA may submit its formal response to the FY 2015 Comprehensive FAME Report to post on OSHA's webpage along with the FAME report. Please submit your formal response in Word instead of PDF. OSHA's web team needs the documents in Word version to facilitate posting in a manner that is in compliance with Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (providing for electronic and information technology to be accessible to individuals with disabilities.) Should OR-OSHA choose to provide formal comments, please submit electronically to me with a courtesy copy to Suzanne Smith, OSP Director (Smith.Suzanne@dol.gov). OSHA will post a link to this information under the FY 2015 Comprehensive FAME Report link on OSHA's website. **If you would like your formal response to be posted at the same time as the FY 2015 FAME report, please provide to me no later than Friday, July 29, 2016.** Information submitted after this date will be posted at OSHA's earliest convenience.
