# Oregon OSHA - Adopted Changes Portable Fire Extinguisher Rules in General Industry

These changes represent an attempt to consolidate, simplify and update the old rules. They were reformatted for ease of reading and plain language. There are no new requirements. The requirement to inspect and maintain extinguishers will change to make following the manufacturers' instructions the primary emphasis on newer extinguishers. The old requirements remain for older extinguishers. These changes conform to rules about extinguisher maintenance and inspection, enforced by the Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal.

This action adopts a new rule, OAR 437-002-0187 Portable Fire Extinguishers, and will repeal the existing fire extinguisher rule OAR 437-002-1910.157. OAR 437-002-1910.66 Powered Platforms, and OAR 437-002-1910.109 Explosives and Blasting Agents, reference the 1910.157 standard. A note will be included at each of these locations to refer the reader to the new fire extinguisher standard OAR 437-002-0187.

This is OR-OSHA Administrative Order 7-2007, adopted and effective November 8, 2007.
