# Oregon OSHA – Adopted Changes With Federal OSHA Remand of Portions of the Vertical Tandem Lifts Standard in Marine Terminals

This rulemaking is to keep Oregon OSHA in harmony with recent changes to Federal OSHA's standards.

Oregon OSHA adopts by reference the amendments to vertical tandem lifts as published in the **April 21, 2014 Federal Register**. Federal OSHA implemented a court-ordered remand of certain portions of the standard for vertical tandem lifts (VTLs). This rulemaking implements the remand by: limiting the application of the corner-casting and interbox-connector inspection requirements to shore-to-ship VTLs; and removing the tandem lifts of platform containers from the scope of the VTL standard.

No comments were received during the open comment period. Oregon OSHA makes this amendment to CFR 1917 Marine Terminals, 1917.71.
