This letter is in response to your question regarding storing material safety data sheets (MSDSs) electronically.

In answer to your question, any business using an electronic means of MSDS retrieval would need to ensure that the MSDSs are available to employees within that employees' work shift, and employers would need to ensure that a backup system is available in the event that the main system is down for maintenance, repair, or power disruption.

With constant advances being made with respect to electronic access to information, OR-OSHA is continually reviewing its requirements. Said another way, our standards in the area may change at any time.
