**SUBJECT:** Pile Driving Clarification: Tying Off Loft Workers, Top Men, or Pile Monks

**AFFECTED STANDARDS/** 

**DIRECTIVES:** 1926.603(a)(8)

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this directive is to clarify the application of 1926.603(a)(8) as

it relates to tying off employees using work platforms or stirrups on sheet

piling.

**BACKGROUND:** As a result of a request to clarify the application of 1926.603(a)(8), note

the following:

1926.603(a)(8) applies only to tying off employees working on fixed leads and not to men working on top of steel sheet piling. However, the loft worker, top-man, or pile-monk on top of the sheeting shall be protected by

the use of a work platform or stirrups.

**ACTION:** Under normal circumstances, COs will not cite employers for failure to tie off

employees using work platforms or stirrups on sheet piling.
