**PURPOSE:** This directive is to inform Oregon OSHA staff of the existence of a federal program directive.

**BACKGROUND:** This directive has not been adopted into state language because of the limited applicability, but is provided to the staff for information.

**ACTION:** This federal directive shall be followed when conducting marine grain elevator inspections which fall into Oregon OSHA's jurisdiction.
