### Lessons Learned:

Dave mentioned some "safety contacts" reminders that deal with weather related surface changes for this time of year to include frozen or leaf covered areas for slippery conditions when driving or walking.

Angie mentioned a recent safety assist that she attempted along the I-5 corridor concerning employees working from an extensible boom lift (JLG) without fall protection.

Mary Lou furthered the conversation to poll the group about the actual responsibilities or potential liabilities of individuals in this group as safety professionals to stop and address identified hazards of other employees. Intervene or not?

The group on a whole felt it was important when appropriate to stop when other employees are in harms way or potentially violating simple safety rules. Regardless of the results it does impact the safety and health of the individuals.

Peggy and other Oregon OSHA staff gave an update: Confined space, Dave McLaughlin is doing a side-by-side comparison document of the proposed Oregon Confined Space rule and the current 1910.146 Federal rule. In that analysis, certain operational components were found to be missing. Oregon OSHA is revisiting certain parts of the rule and plans to reconvene the committees in January.

The Standards Improvement Project (SIP III) is finalized. A hearing was held with no comments. Plans are to delay enforcement for the PPE assessment on the torso provision (only) for six months. The effective date for the respirator medical evaluations in the vertical standards is being pushed out until July 1, 2012.

Penalties- The second of two hearings will be held 12/7/2011 at the Portland, Oregon OSHA office at 10:00 AM. The first hearing had a couple of concerns pertaining to the assessment of the good faith.

Michael was approached by the NECA/ IBEW management group to get a sense of possibly creating acceptable training specific requirements for specialty cranes such as digger derricks when used in electrical work that does not involve power generation, transmission and distribution.

Barry mentioned the EEI settlement that Federal OSHA has posted concerning digger derricks and emphasized the difficulty for employers to have operators trained on larger cranes that they will never use.

It was suggested that this advisory committee form a sub-committee to review the industry practices and realities for crane use, looking at types of work rather than industry wide construction crane operations. Revisit the topic next meeting.

Chris and Peggy spoke to issues around lead assessment as it relates to the lead-based paint industry. The <u>publication</u> and a letter of interpretation dated <u>July 18, 2003</u> was handed out. If members have additional questions contact Chris @ 503 947 7388
