Lessons Learned:

Brian Silbernagel spoke about a near fatal that occurred when a socket fell 130 feet hitting an employee. A sub-contractor borrowed a wrench for tightening bolts on a tower crane. Most wrenches have auto locking or securing devices and others have manually pinned sockets attaching the wrench to the socket. The socket was used unpinned and fell hitting the employee below causing fractured ribs and a punctured lung.

There was a discussion about the hazards related to grinding wheels. Ellis agreed to write an article for the next Construction Depot on this subject. Brian suggested a section in the Construction Depot dedicated to tools and their proper use, maintenance care, etc. The information may be valuable when proposing a new wood working rule. Ellis suggested adding a tool box column to the Construction Depot that could feature a different tool each time. Elliot asked is the Sawstop brand table saw (<u>http://www.sawstop.com/</u>) required to be guarded with the traditional guards. The answer was Yes.

July 19, 2012 Oregon OSHA – Proposed Changes with Federal OSHA amendments for GHS forHazard Communication in General Industry, Construction, and Shipyard Employment. Public Hearing Scheduled for: September 5, 2012 10:00 am Labor & Industries Building, Basement – Conference Room F

Confined space still projected to be proposed by the end of July with a effective date of January 2013.

Last month Ron asked if Oregon OSHA should incorporate the Division 2 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) rules into Division 3 Construction rules. As a part of this rule making Oregon OSHA would also make the skylight covering provision in General Industry and Construction the same. The committee heard a motion to move forward on the PPE proposal, it was seconded and approved.

Gary reminded the committee that the new penalty rules were in effect July 1.
