Small Capacity Cranes in Construction – No news from federal OSHA. Crane certification providers are reporting that employers are waiting to see what federal OSHA requires.

Oregon OSHA Press Release: Oregon OSHA cited Munoz Construction \$70,000 for not protecting its employees from falls. The fine was based on a willful violation and was the result of an inspection at a Portland apartment complex on Feb. 27, 2013. The employer appealed the citation but agreed to it following an informal conference with Oregon OSHA.
