

§1910.101 OAR 437-002-0000 Compressed Gases (General Requirements).

(a) Inspection of compressed gas cylinders. Each employer ~~shall~~must conduct a visual inspection of ~~determine that~~ compressed gas cylinders under ~~their~~his control to determine they are in a safe condition. ~~to the extent that this can be determined by visual inspection.~~ Visual and other inspections ~~must~~shall be conducted as prescribed in the Hazardous Materials Regulations of the Department of Transportation (49 CFR Parts 171-179 and 14 CFR Part 103). Where those regulations are not applicable, visual and other inspections ~~must~~shall be conducted in accordance with Compressed Gas Association (CGA Pamphlets C-6-1968 and C-8-1962, Pamphlets C-6-2013 11th edition and CGA C-8 2005, Reaffirmed 2010 7th edition) which ~~are~~is incorporated by reference as specified in §1910.6.

(b) Compressed gases. The ~~in-plant~~ handling, storage, and utilization of all compressed gases in cylinders, portable tanks, rail tankcars, or motor vehicle cargo tanks ~~must~~shall be in accordance with Compressed Gas Association Pamphlet ~~P-1-1965, P-1 2008 11th edition~~ which is incorporated by reference as specified in §1910.6.

(c) Safety relief devices for compressed gas containers. Compressed gas cylinders, portable tanks, and cargo tanks ~~must~~shall have pressure relief devices installed and maintained in accordance with Compressed Gas Association Pamphlets ~~S-1.1-1963, CGA S-1.1 2011 14th edition and 1965 addenda and S-1.2-1963, CGA S-1.2 2009 9th edition~~ which is incorporated by reference as specified in §1910.6.
