
## **Agricultural employer requirements**







Agricultural employers who are subject to the Worker Protection Standard and who have enclosed structures within an Application Exclusion Zone (AEZ), must ensure the following *prior to a pesticide application*:



**All doors and windows** on the structure **must be closed**.



Any **air intake devices** that bring air within the structure **must be turned off**.



Personal and household items that are not inside the home/building must be stored or otherwise protected from potential contamination.



For structures where people live, a closeable storage area for shoes and boots must be provided to help prevent tracking of pesticide residue from the outside areas into the space.



Items 1-3 apply to all enclosed agricultural homes/buildings. All the requirements shown above apply to structures where people live.
