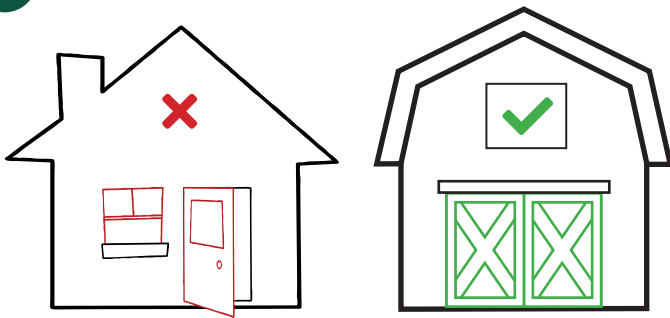


Agricultural employer requirements for protecting agricultural structures that fall within the Application Exclusion Zone for outdoor crop areas

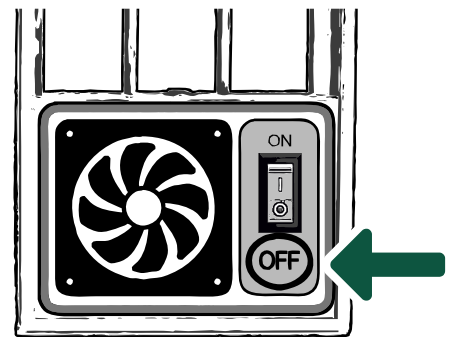
Agricultural employers who are subject to the Worker Protection Standard and who have enclosed structures within an Application Exclusion Zone (AEZ), must ensure the following *prior to a pesticide application*:

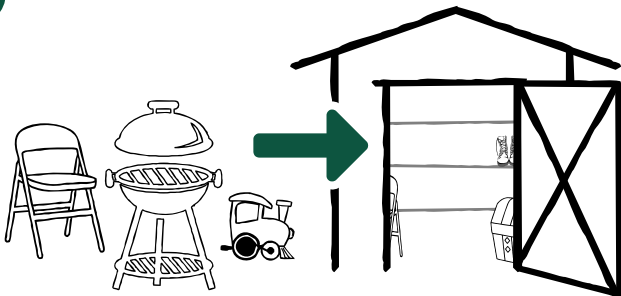
All doors and windows on the structure must be closed.

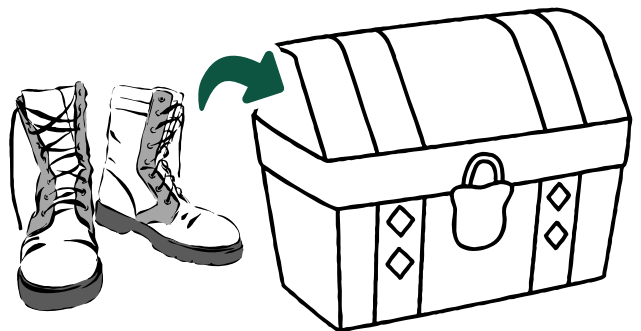
Any air intake devices that bring air within the structure must be turned off.

Personal and household items that are not inside the home/building must be stored or otherwise protected from potential contamination.

For structures where people live, a closeable storage area for shoes and boots must be provided to help prevent tracking of pesticide residue from the outside areas into the space.



Items 1-3 apply to all enclosed agricultural homes/buildings. All the requirements shown above apply to structures where people live.
