

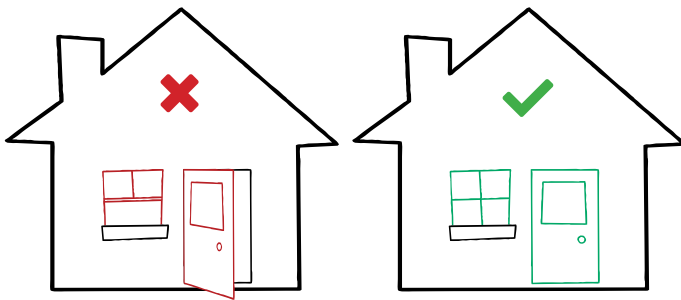
Agricultural employer requirements

for securing agricultural structures that fall within the Application Exclusion Zone for outdoor crop areas



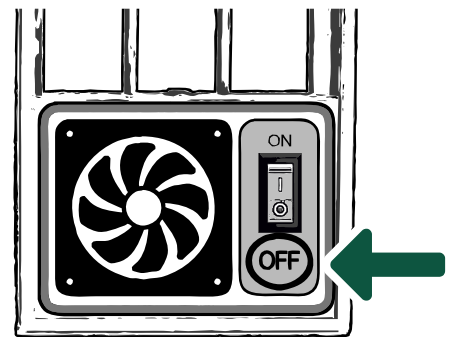
Starting Jan. 1, 2019, agricultural employers who are subject to the Worker Protection Standard and who have enclosed structures within an Application Exclusion Zone (AEZ), must ensure the following *prior to pesticide application*:

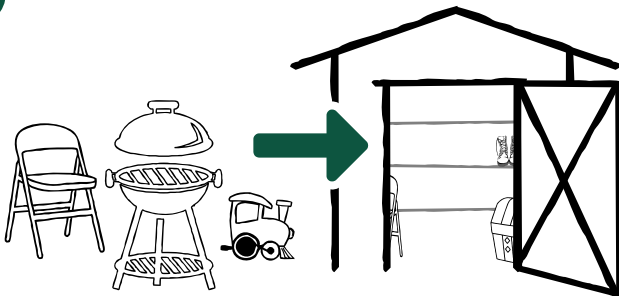
All doors and windows on the structure must be closed.

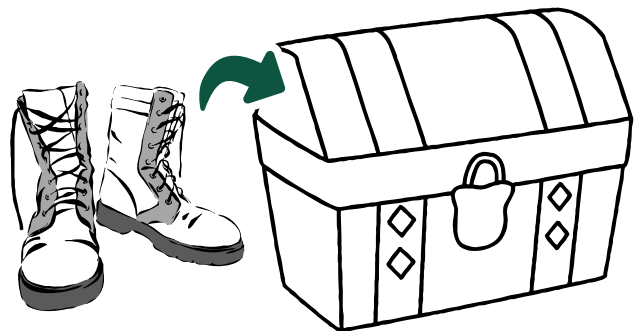
Any air intake devices on the structure must be turned off.

Personal or household items that are not inside the structure must be stored or otherwise protected from potential contamination.

For structures where people live, a closeable storage area for shoes and boots must be provided to help prevent tracking of pesticide residues from the outside areas into the space.



Items 1-3 apply to all enclosed agricultural structures. All the requirements shown above apply to structures where people live.
