**RULE SUMMARY**

Oregon OSHA adopted the Federal OSHA changes as they appear in the November 15, 2007 Federal Register, into Division 2/I, Personal Protective Equipment, Division 3/E, Personal Protective and Life Saving Equipment, and Division 5, Maritime Activities. The changes codify and clarify the employers' responsibility to provide and pay for protective equipment that is necessary for employees to perform their jobs safely.

In addition to the Federal OSHA changes, Oregon OSHA proposes to replace the existing language in Division 4/I, Protective Equipment, with language comparable to the new Federal OSHA language for clarity.
