Dear Mr. Jacksch:

This is in response to your letter requesting information about the storage of Garlon-4 and crop oil.

Oregon OSHA general industry standards are not specific to the storage of this material. OAR 437-002-1910.176(b) says in part, "Storage of material shall not create a hazard."

We interpret this to mean that you must follow any recommendations and restrictions set by the manufacturer either on the product label or on its MSDS.

We have no separate standard that requires locked storage for these chemicals.
