

PROGRAM DIRECTIVE

Program Directive A-170
Issued October 1, 1992
Revised October 21, 1993

SUBJECT: Memorandum of Understanding Between Federal OSHA and Employment Standards Administration, Wage and Hour Division, OSHA Instruction CPL 2.92

AFFECTED CODES/

DIRECTIVES: Oregon State Plan, I-7 (S-2) and Appendix F, Part S-2

PURPOSE: This directive is to inform OR-OSHA staff of the existence of an agreement between Federal OSHA and ESA concerning jurisdiction and referral methods for observed violations of labor and safety rules.

BACKGROUND: This directive has not been adopted into state language because of the limited applicability in Oregon due to the local jurisdiction of the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) and OR-OSHA.

ACTION: OR-OSHA staff will honor the intent of this Memorandum of Understanding as it relates to OR-OSHA and BOLI. Referrals, training and coordination shall be accomplished as set forth in the Interagency Agreements between OR-OSHA and BOLI and the Field Compliance Manual procedures. Additional material (directory and code lists) will be stored in the PD file.
