PURPOSE: To inform Oregon OSHA staff of the existence of federal program directive.

BACKGROUND: This directive has not been adopted into State language because of its limited application, but is provided for staff information.

ACTION: This federal directive will be followed (see page 3, Section VI) when determining Oregon OSHA jurisdiction and enforcement, on the Outer Continental Shelf of the Coast of Oregon.

DATE:** This directive is effective immediately and will remain in effect until cancelled or superseded.
