Outstanding Safety and Health Program

This award recognizes companies of all sizes that excel in addressing the seven major elements of an effective occupational safety and health program along with an effective safety committee. The company must demonstrate the effectiveness of their activities by a steady or declining recordable incident rate over the past three years. The company must not have experienced a fatality or catastrophic accident within the previous 12 months.

SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Submit a summary not more than two (2) typewritten pages explaining the accomplishments of your company in addressing the elements of your safety and health program. The summary is evaluated on your explanation and examples of success in these areas:

- Management commitment
- Labor and management accountability
- Employee involvement
- Hazard Identification and control
- Periodic plan evaluation
- Worker training
- Incident/Accident reports

Safety Committee Recognition

This award recognizes an outstanding safety committee, its members, and activities that have made a significant contribution towards the company's overall success. Businesses of qualifying safety committees must not have experienced a fatality or catastrophic accident within the previous 12 months.

SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Submit a written summary of no more than two (2) typewritten pages of safety committee accomplishments to include:

- a meeting agenda
- a list of current members
- copies of safety committee minutes for the past twelve months
- at least quarterly inspection findings

Innovations in Safety

This award recognizes an individual or group for developing and implementing innovative safety solutions in the workplace. The innovation should be new to the work team or organization and make a meaningful difference in safety of the employees and/or public. Innovations can include new ways of performing work or improved or new tools. Recipients will be evaluated for innovation, simplicity, cost savings and risk reduction for their company or industry.

SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Submit a written summary of no more than two (2) typewritten pages about the safety innovation to include:

- Describe the work practice, method or tool including how the innovation was developed, implemented and is used today.
- Demonstrate how the innovation has improved safety for the work team, organization or the public.
- Demonstrate how the innovation has reduced risk and saved money.

Speak Up! for Safety

This award recognizes an individual or group for expressing concern or interest in a safety issue that helps an organization or community avoid or address a potential hazard.

SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Submit a written summary of no more than two (2) typewritten pages about the advocacy including:

- Describe how the individual or group demonstrated caring of others by speaking up, raising awareness, or advocating for others.
- Demonstrate how the concern was shared, received and addressed.

Safety Professional of the Year (SPY)

This award honors an outstanding safety professional from ASSP Cascade Chapter. The nominee should have made a significant contribution to the local safety and health community through outstanding technical work, contributions to their employers safety and health programs, and volunteerism and activities with the safety community and the local ASSP chapter.

SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Submit a written summary of no more than two (2) typewritten pages addressing the specific reasons why the nominated person is outstanding in the safety profession, including the following:

- Demonstrates knowledge and expertise as a safety professional
- Demonstrates ability to work within a company to provide a safe and health working environment and develop effective safety and health programs
- Contributes to the ASSP Chapter, responsibilities and activities undertaken on behalf of the chapter, offices held, willingness to volunteer
- Mentors and teaches within the safety community
- Community service and volunteerism
- Academic and professional credentials
