| Oregon OSHA's state – Oregon OSHA will allow employers to comply with either the state-initiated rule or the federal rule until revisions to the state-initiated rule are finalized. Small Capacity Cranes in Construction – No news from federal OSHA. Crane certification providers are reporting that employers are waiting to see what federal OSHA requires.

Monthly Overnight Hospitalizations & Fatalities Report

Jeff gave a report of fatalities and overnight hospitalizations in Construction for the month of September. There was 1 fatality and 6 overnight hospitalizations.

9/6/2013	Sandy	Roofing	A crew of five workers was installing roof trusses on a shop under construction. After the 13th truss was set in place the entire group of trusses fell over and collapsed into the structure. One of the crew was killed and several others were taken to trauma centers.

Roundtable:

Oregon OSHA Press Release: Oregon OSHA cited Munoz Construction \$70,000 for not protecting its employees from falls. The fine was based on a willful violation and was the result of an inspection at a Portland apartment complex on Feb. 27, 2013. The employer appealed the citation but agreed to it following an informal conference with Oregon OSHA.
